## Case Study #2

- Ciba Geigy Superfund Site, Toms River, NJ
- Plume exceeds five square miles
- Over 50 recovery wells
- Many miles of transmission pipeline
- System involves groundwater recovery, pumping to central location, precipitation of inorganics followed by activated carbon adsorption
- Pump rebuilding was costing about \$200,000 annually
- Since 1999, Redux has provided systems for 20 different recovery pump and associated pipelines
